These plants are easy to grow, edible and make a great companion plant. They thrive in poor soils and are rich in vitamin C. The flowers leaves and buds are edible and have a peppery flavour. Add them to your salads, soups, casseroles or your favourite pesto recipe.

You can stuff the leaves and bake them in place of grape vine leaves or pick the buds while still green then pickle them in vinegar and use them like capers. These hardy plants are a colourful addition to your garden.
