This year BPS held a Remembrance Day service at Brooklyn War Memorial in conjunction with the Brooklyn RSL. The service was led by our school captain Arlo and House Captain Roland, to commemorate those who fought and died in conflicts since World War 1. During this service, we paused for one minute's silence to remember the servicemen and women who gave their lives while serving Australia in wars, conflicts and peace -keeping operations. The Last Post was played beautifully by Arlo, to signify that soldiers have gone to their final rest. Students then placed a poppy in the sand by the wreath at the base of the memorial.

Intention to Apply for Year 7 Placement in a Selective High School in 2024

Selective high schools cater for academically gifted students with high potential who may otherwise be without sufficient classmates at their own academic standard. Selective high schools help these students to learn by grouping them with students of similar ability, and by using specialised teaching methods.

If you would like to have your child considered for Year 7 selective high school entry in 2024, you need to apply on the internet using a valid email address (not the student's email address).

The Selective High School Placement Test will be held on **Thursday 4th May 2023**.

Detailed instructions on how to apply and the link to the online form will be available in early-October 2022 at <u>https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-</u> <u>schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-</u> <u>classes/year-7</u>.

Applications open on 18 October 2022 and close on 16 November 2022. You must apply before the closing date.

You must submit only ONE application for each student.

Intention to apply letters and an information booklet were emailed to Year 5 parents.

To achieve badge status, Harry has received 40 Brookie awards this year for being a responsible, respectful and resilient learner who strives for excellence.


